Where will we stay?

Gretna Glen has eight heated cabins, each featuring beds for 14 guests. Confirmands and Counselors will be sleeping in bunk beds and will need to bring: sleeping bags, pillows, towels, toiletries, etc. The shower house and bathrooms are centrally located to the cabins and are also heated.

Who: This camp is for Jr. and Sr. High youth who are currently involved with the confirmation program in their local church. This camp is designed for entire classes to attend together with their pastor and/or instructor. However, individual campers are also welcome with adult counselors.

Counselors can be the Pastors, laypersons, mentors, and/or parents. If you volunteer to be a counselor, you will receive an informational guide to prepare you for the weekend.
